The NVQ is designed to assess an individual's competence within their job role. However, the programme can include the development and enhancement of knowledge and skills to meet the individual needs of the business

Programme Overview

This programme is delivered via On Site Assessment and Training (OSAT) which helps individuals turn their existing skills and experience into a nationally recognised qualification. Content is flexible.

What does the programme contain?

There are 2 mandatory units:

- Conform to general workplace safety
- Conform to efficient work practices

An additional unit from the following should be completed:

- Establish work area protection and safety

- Segregate the area for highways works

There are then 7 potential routes to choose from within this qualification, depending on specific requirements:

- Modular pavement constructions
- Laying kerbs and channels
- Drainage construction
- Structural concreting
- General construction
- Excavation and reinstatement and general building operations

Programme duration:

An average of 6-9 months to complete the programme dependant on business and individual training needs.

Programme cost:

Rates are negotiable depending on business volume. Full funding may be available.
